REDISCOVERING THE ART OF DYING: How Jesus' Experience and Our Stories Reveal a New Vision of Compassionate Care. Join seekers from across the country for a six-session series offered bi-weekly on zoom as we begin a new year and journey through the season of Lent. Ana Gheyssen will be your guide through the incredibly moving book by Nuala Kenny, Rediscovering the Art of Dying: How Jesus' Experience and Our Stories Reveal a New Vision of Compassionate Care. We will journey together with Jesus from the Garden of Gethsemane to the Resurrection through presentations, small group discussions and time for individual journaling and personal reflection. Death and dying are difficult topics to face. This series provides a sacred container for us so

that this process feels a little more doable. As we work through the book, we will confront our own mortality, our ideas about the meaning of suffering, fears about what the end of life is like, questions about hospice and palliative care, and the role of ritual after death.
